FORGOTTEN, BUT NOT UNIMPORTANT

Do you recognize the name Michael Collins? You might know someone with that name, but the individual I am speaking of was an integral part of a famous trio. His two colleagues are more recognizable--Buzz Aldrin and Neil Armstrong. These two (Aldrin and Armstrong) landed on the surface of the moon and are remembered easily, but it was Collins who circled the moon in the command module on the Apollo 11 mission waiting for the other two to lift off and rejoin him. Collins never had the privilege of stepping foot on the lunar surface, but his work was just as important and essential to the success of the mission as that of Aldrin and Armstrong.

Sometimes there are people in our congregations, in our workplace, and even in our families, among other places that are often forgotten because they do not have the glamorous job. They work behind the scenes doing the "grunt work." They are usually only noticed when one of those with a more public profile messes something up and blames them for the problem or due to some other type of unfair treatment. The work they do is vital and essential to the overall success of the larger group, and I salute the efforts they make and aim to show greater appreciation to them in the future.

If you feel like you are one of these "forgotten ones", rest assured that the work you do is valuable and vital. If you are tempted to think that no one notices or cares, and by the lack of gratitude and appreciation this seems like a logical conclusion, keep this verse in mind: "For God is not unjust to forget your work and labor of love which you have shown toward His name, *in that* you have ministered to the saints, and do minister." (Hebrews 6:10).

Have you considered those unnamed individuals who made a big difference, but whose names were not included in Scripture? Who was the boy who decided to share his lunch so that Jesus could feed 5,000 men plus women and children as John 6:1-14 describes? What about the little girl who informed Naaman's wife that the prophet in Israel could cure the dreaded disease of leprosy as we read in 2 Kings 5? Or, which of the disciples held the rope or other restraining device attached to the basket let down in an opening in the city wall that allowed Paul to escape the plot against his life in Damascus recorded in Acts 9:24-25?

The truth is the names of none of the individuals involved in the above incidents are recorded, but this in no way minimizes the important work they did. Perhaps, God will grant us the opportunity in eternity to know these individuals and give them our gratitude for what they did. Similarly, there are many unnamed ones doing great things for God today. Many of them are in this congregation and do not desire or receive the recognition for the great work they do, but remember God sees and God knows!

Michael Collins will probably never be remembered with the same lore of Neil Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin, but without him (Collins), they (Armstrong & Aldrin) would have never made it back to earth to celebrate their exploits. In the same way, your name may not be recognized by the masses. It may be that by your work the business you work for is more productive, your family is more loving and most importantly some will have Heaven as their eternal home and for that we salute you!
